Please note that the first months' Homestay Fee (CDN \$1,050) must also be paid to the Chilliwack School District, along with the Application Fee, and the Program Fees Deposit. Therefore, the total initial payment must be a minimum of \$4,350. Conversely, parents may wish to pay all fees owing in one payment instead of two.

Payments may be made via Flywire, Bank Draft, or Certified Cheque, in Canadian funds.

#### INSURANCE

Through our International Student Program, students are provided with medical insurance coverage with a private insurance company and then, when eligible, also with British Columbia Provincial health insurance. Insurance coverage will be provided during the entire length of the student's stay in Canada.

#### **HOMESTAY COSTS**

The Homestay Fee is \$1,050 per month and covers the student's accommodation and meals. The fee for the entire period of the student's stay is paid in advance to the School District and the School District then pays the homestay family the stipend on a monthly basis on the student's behalf.

International Students are expected to pay the full amount of the monthly homestay fee for months such as December, January, and March, even if they leave the homestay residence during a holiday period. With regards to the month of June, if the student leaves the homestay residence on or before June 15th (and notifies the Homestay Coordinator of the intention to do so by June 1st), the student will only have to make the homestay payment for the first half of June (\$525). However, if the student leaves the homestay residence after June 15<sup>th</sup>. the student is responsible for paying the full month's homestay fee (\$1,050).

### ADDITIONAL COSTS

International Students will not be charged additional fees for items which are required costs of the school and the classes they are enrolled in. For example, locker fees, Physical Education class fees, art project fees, etc. However, they are expected to pay for items which are completely optional and at the discretion of the student. Examples of which would be things like, joining the school ski club, sports teams, courtesy bussing (transportation), etc.

#### REFUND POLICY

Full refund, less Application Fee, and the first month's Homestay Fee if student authorization is not approved by Canadian Embassy or Consulate (letter of rejection from High Commission must be included).

If a student cancels before the program begins, two thirds of the full Tuition Fee is refundable.

If a student voluntarily leaves the program within 30 days of beginning, half of the full Tuition Fee is refundable.

If the status of the student changes after September 30<sup>th</sup> to Non-fee Paying as defined by SD33 Administrative Regulation 321.1, there will be **NO REFUND** of international fees for that school year.

30 days after the commencement of classes **OR** in the event of being required to leave the program because of faulty documents, failure to obey Program Rules, or being charged with a criminal act in Canada, NO REFUND is provided.

Please Note: In all of the aforementioned situations there will be no refund of Application Fee and first month's Homestay Fee.

The Board and school will not be liable for losses or expenses you may incur as a result of the Board being unable to provide education owing to labour disputes or other causes beyond its control. Fees will be refunded only if the education program in which the student is enrolled cannot be completed within the enrollment term.
