<sup>1.</sup> An additional fee of \$100 – \$200 may be added to the monthly Homestay Fee for the following dietary considerations: gluten free (Celiac), vegan, vegetarian, pescatarian, and lactose free. Other dietary considerations will be evaluated on a case-by-case basis.

<sup>2.</sup> The Program Fee includes both Tuition and Medical Insurance coverage.

<sup>3.</sup> If a student requires that their transcripts are legally validated, an additional \$275 Transcript Validation Fee will be applied.

<sup>4.</sup> If a student requests busing, an additional Courtesy Ridership Fee may be incurred.

Please note that the Application Fee, Homestay Placement Fee, Custodianship Fee, and the first month Homestay Fee must be paid to the Chilliwack School District before a Letter of Acceptance and Custodial Documents are provided. Therefore, the total initial payment must be a minimum of \$2,500. Conversely, parents may wish to pay all fees owing in one payment instead of two. Any remaining fees are due 60 days before the commencement of a student's program.

Payments may be made via Flywire, Wire Transfer, Bank Draft, or Certified Cheque, in Canadian funds.

## INSURANCE

Through our International Student Program, students are provided medical insurance coverage with StudyInsured<sup>™</sup>, and then, when eligible, also with British Columbia Provincial Health Insurance (MSP). Insurance coverage will be provided during the entire length of the student's stay in Canada.

## HOMESTAY COSTS

The Homestay Fee covers the student's accommodation and meals. The fee for the entire period of the student's stay is paid in advance to the School District and the School District then pays the homestay family the monthly stipend on the student's behalf.

International Students are expected to pay the full amount of the monthly Homestay Fee for months such as December, January, and March, even if they leave the homestay residence during a holiday period.

With regards to the month of June, if the student leaves the homestay residence on or before June 15<sup>th</sup> (and notifies the Homestay Coordinator of the intention to do so by June 1st, the student will only have to make the homestay payment for the first half of June. However, if the student leaves the homestay residence after June 15<sup>th</sup>, the student is responsible for paying the full month's homestay fee.

An additional fee of \$100 - \$200 will be added to the monthly Homestay Fee for the following dietary considerations:

- gluten free (Celiac)
- vegan
- vegetarian
- pescatarian
- lactose free

Other dietary considerations will be evaluated on a case-by-case basis.

## ADDITIONAL COSTS

International Students will not be charged additional fees for items which are required costs of the school and the classes they are enrolled in. For example, locker fees, Physical Education class fees, art project fees, etc. However, they are expected to pay for items which are completely optional and at the discretion of the student. Examples of which would be things like, joining the school ski club, sports teams, courtesy bussing (transportation), etc.
